Senator Hamrick of the 30th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend HB 1176 (LC 29 5281S) by replacing lines 1 through 5 with the following:*

2 To amend Chapter 7 of Title 5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to appeal
3 or certiorari by the state in criminal cases, so as to change provisions relating to the state's
4 right to appeal; to amend Titles 15, 16, 17, 35, and 42 of the Official Code of

5 *By replacing lines 46 through 52 with the following:*

6 Chapter 7 of Title 5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to appeal or
7 certiorari by the state in criminal cases, is amended by revising paragraph (7) of subsection
8 (a) of Code Section 5-7-1, relating to orders, decisions, or judgments appealable, as follows:

9 "(7) From an order, decision, or judgment of a ~~superior~~ court granting a motion for new
10 trial or an extraordinary motion for new trial;"

11 **SECTION 1-2.**

12 Said chapter is further amended by revising paragraph (2) of subsection (b) of Code Section
13 5-7-2, relating to certification required for immediate review of nonfinal orders, decisions,
14 or judgments and exceptions, as follows:

15 "(2) Order, decision, or judgment described in paragraph (1) or (7) of subsection (a) of
16 Code Section 5-7-1."
