Senators Grant of the 25th and Hamrick of the 30th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the House Committee on Judiciary, Non-civil substitute to SB 366 (LC 29 5263S) by*
2 *revising lines 1 and 2 as follows:*

3 To amend Code Section 15-11-66 and Chapter 4A of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia
4 Annotated, relating to the disposition of delinquent children and the Department of Juvenile
5 Justice, respectively, so as to change provisions relating to detention of juveniles; to revise
6 restrictions regarding possession of

7 *By inserting between lines 6 and 7 the following:*

8 Code Section 15-11-66 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the disposition
9 of delinquent children, is amended by revising subparagraph (b)(2)(B) as follows:

10 "(B) A child ordered to a youth development center under this paragraph and detained
11 in a secured facility pending placement in the youth development center shall be given
12 credit for time served in the secured facility awaiting placement. ~~On and after July 1,~~
13 ~~2013, the maximum number of days that the court may order a child to serve in a youth~~
14 ~~development center under this paragraph shall be increased to 60 days."~~
