A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Chief Jimmy Anderson; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Chief Jimmy Anderson of the Trion Fire Department was awarded a plaque for
3 valor by the Georgia State Firefighters Association and Georgia Association of Fire Chiefs
4 at the 40th annual Firefighter's Recognition Day; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the Trion Fire Department was dispatched to a cardiac arrest incident; and
- 6 WHEREAS, upon arrival, Chief Anderson, along with Captain Ben Bandy, determined that
7 the patient had no pulse, immediately started CPR, and used an AED for additional
8 life-saving support; and
- 9 WHEREAS, shortly thereafter, Emergency Medical Services arrived, were able to find a
10 pulse, and had the patient transported to Redmond Hospital; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Chief Anderson accompanied the EMS unit to the hospital to give his assistance
12 to the paramedic and EMT; and
- 13 WHEREAS, due to Chief Anderson's extraordinary efforts, the patient improved quickly
14 with minimal residual effects from the cardiac arrest; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Chief Anderson's training and experience played an instrumental role in the
16 outcome; and
- 17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary accomplishments of
18 this distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body commend the courageous and selfless dedication of Chief Jimmy
21 Anderson and recognize him for being awarded a plaque for valor.

23 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Chief Jimmy Anderson.
