A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Cancer Treatment Centers of America; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Cancer Treatment Centers of America (CTCA) will open the doors of its new
3 regional hospital in Newnan, Georgia, to patients and their families from across the Southeast
4 in August of 2012; and

5 WHEREAS, CTCA specializes in complex and advance stage cancer care; and

6 WHEREAS, CTCA has delivered the Mother Standard of care and Patient Empowerment
7 Medicine since its inception in 1988; and

8 WHEREAS, CTCA is committed to providing all the information cancer patients and their
9 families need, empowering them to make treatment decisions that are best for them; and

10 WHEREAS, the CTCA Patient Empowerment Care model combines state-of-the-art clinical
11 treatment and technology with an array of complementary therapies to help manage side
12 effects and improve quality of life; and

13 WHEREAS, more than two-thirds of patients are expected to come from outside the State
14 of Georgia, contributing to the growth and vitality of the local economy; and

15 WHEREAS, CTCA of the Southeast is expected to generate \$500 million in economic
16 activity over the first five years and create approximately 500 new jobs after the fifth year
17 of operation; and

18 WHEREAS, Cancer Treatment Centers of America will be a visible and valued member of
19 the Newnan and Coweta County communities and the State of Georgia, and it is abundantly
20 fitting and proper that its outstanding contributions be appropriately recognized.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 the members of this body commend Cancer Treatment Centers of America for its work on
23 the prevention, early detection, treatment, and its goal of the eventual eradication of cancer
24 and its contributions to the State of Georgia.
