- 3 WHEREAS, On Common Ground News was established in April of 1995 as a community
- 4 newsletter covering seven communities in South DeKalb County by Mr. Glenn L. Morgan,
- 5 an entrepreneur who wanted to connect the many transplants in the area where he lived with

- 13 WHEREAS, in 2003, On Common Ground, Inc., became a broadsheet newspaper under the
- 14 name On Common Ground News and began publishing twice a month by the end of the year;

- 16 WHEREAS, today, On Common Ground News serves communities in Atlanta, DeKalb,
- 17 Gwinnett, Henry, and Rockdale counties, publishing a print edition on the first and 15th of
- 18 each month and a weekly digital edition; and
- 19 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the contributions of this distinguished
- 20 newspaper be appropriately recognized during this special time.
- 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 22 commend Mr. Glenn L. Morgan and On Common Ground News for 17 years of connecting
