

House Bill 1026 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 15-16-13 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 authorization of law enforcement contracts with municipalities, reimbursement, employment
3 and expenditures, and exception, so as to change the provisions relative to population
4 brackets and the census regarding the exception to such Code section; to provide an effective
5 date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 15-16-13 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to authorization
9 of law enforcement contracts with municipalities, reimbursement, employment and
10 expenditures, and exception, is amended by revising subsection (f) as follows:

11 "(f) This Code section shall not apply to any county of ~~800,000~~ 900,000 population or
12 more according to the United States decennial census of ~~2000~~ 2010 or any future such
13 census."

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012.

16 **SECTION 3.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
