

## Senate Resolution 1366

## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Daniel S. Papp; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Dr. Daniel S. Papp has long been recognized for the vital role that he has played  
3 in higher education and his deep personal commitment to students; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Dr. Papp is a Phi Beta Kappa graduate of Dartmouth College and earned a  
5 Ph.D. in international affairs from the University of Miami; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he joined Georgia Tech's faculty in 1973 as an assistant professor of  
7 international affairs, became director of Georgia Tech's School of Social Sciences from 1980  
8 to 1990, founding director of Georgia Tech's Sam Nunn School of International Affairs from  
9 1990 to 1993, an executive assistant to the president of Georgia Tech from 1994 to 1997,  
10 interim president of Southern Polytechnic State University from 1997 to 1998, senior vice  
11 chancellor for academics and fiscal affairs of the University System of Georgia from 2000  
12 to 2006, and is currently president of Kennesaw State University; and
- 13 WHEREAS, under his leadership, KSU has risen in academic stature as it became a  
14 doctorate-granting institution and launched its first Ph.D. program; and
- 15 WHEREAS, since Dr. Papp became president, KSU also completed its transition to NCAA  
16 Division I and expanded its infrastructure with the opening of state-of-the-art buildings, such  
17 as the student dining hall, the 8,300 seat KSU soccer stadium, and the health sciences  
18 building; and
- 19 WHEREAS, in 1993, he was recognized as Georgia Tech's "Distinguished Professor," the  
20 first time the honor went to faculty other than an engineer or physical scientist, and has been  
21 awarded the Army's Outstanding Civilian Service Medal twice; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Papp has authored or edited ten books and has published more than 60  
23 journal articles and chapters in edited books; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary accomplishments of  
25 this distinguished gentleman be appropriately recognized.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
27 commend Dr. Daniel S. Papp for his sacrifice, foresight, accomplishment, and contributions  
28 on behalf of education and for the positive influence he has had upon the lives and futures  
29 of countless young people.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
31 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Dr. Daniel S. Papp.
