A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Ms. Marcia D. Wallace on the occasion of her retirement; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Ms. Marcia D. Wallace has long been recognized by the citizens of this state
4 for the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the
5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by her 21 years of superlative service with the Georgia General Assembly; and

19 patience and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the
20 citizens of this state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and
21 associates; and

23 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

24 WHEREAS, Ms. Wallace has served with honor and distinction with the Georgia General
25 Assembly and her vision and unyielding commitment will be sorely missed upon the
26 occasion of her retirement; and

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
28 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
