## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to state license requirements and regulations for manufacture, distribution, and
- 3 package sales, so as to provide for the issuance of a manufacturer's or distiller's license to a
- 4 fruit grower for the manufacture of distilled spirits under certain circumstances; to provide
- 5 for the issuance of a manufacturer's or distiller's license authorizing the manufacture of
- 6 distilled spirits from agricultural products other than perishable fruits grown in this state
- 7 under certain circumstances; to change certain provisions relating to the sale or disposal of
- 8 certain distilled spirits or alcohol; to provide for certain educational and promotional tours;
- 9 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

11 SECTION 1.

- 12 Article 2 of Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state
- 13 license requirements and regulations for manufacture, distribution, and package sales, is
- amended by revising Code Section 3-4-24, relating to the issuance to fruit growers of license
- 15 to manufacture distilled spirits, storage and disposition, limitations upon manufacture and
- sale, issuance of manufacturer's or distiller's license in certain counties or municipalities, as
- 17 follows:

- 18 "3-4-24.
- 19 (a) The commissioner may issue a license to a fruit grower authorizing the grower to
- 20 manufacture distilled spirits from perishable fruits grown in this state.
- 21 (b) If any distilled spirits are manufactured as permitted by this Code section in any
- county, municipality, or county area exclusive of certain incorporated areas, as the case
- may be, in which the distilled spirits are not to be sold under the terms of this chapter, the
- 24 licensee shall immediately store the distilled spirits or alcohol in a warehouse or
- 25 warehouses designated by the commissioner to be sold or disposed of under the supervision

of the commissioner in states, counties, or municipalities permitting the legal sale of

- 27 distilled spirits or alcohol.
- 28 (c) It is unlawful for the licensee to sell or dispose of any such distilled spirits or alcohol:
- 29 (1) In any municipality, county, or unincorporated area of a county in which the sale of
- distilled spirits or alcohol is prohibited by this chapter; or
- 31 (2) To any person not holding a wholesale or retail an importer's, broker's, or
- 32 <u>wholesaler's</u> license issued pursuant to this chapter <u>or by another state</u>.
- 33 (d) No  $\underline{A}$  manufacturer's or distiller's license shall may be issued pursuant to this Code
- section to a fruit grower for the manufacture of distilled spirits in any county or
- municipality of this state that has not approved either the package sale of distilled spirits
- or the sale of distilled spirits by the drink, or both, as provided in this chapter.
- 37 (e) A manufacturer or distiller issued a license pursuant to this Code section may provide
- 38 educational and promotional tours."

39 SECTION 2.

- 40 Said article is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 41 <u>3-4-24.1.</u>
- 42 (a) The commissioner may issue a license authorizing the manufacture of distilled spirits
- from agricultural products other than perishable fruits grown in this state.
- 44 (b) If any distilled spirits are manufactured as permitted by this Code section in any
- 45 <u>county, municipality, or county area exclusive of certain incorporated areas, as the case</u>
- 46 may be, in which the distilled spirits are not to be sold under the terms of this chapter, the
- 47 <u>licensee shall immediately store the distilled spirits or alcohol in a warehouse or</u>
- 48 warehouses designated by the commissioner to be sold or disposed of under the supervision
- of the commissioner in states, counties, or municipalities permitting the legal sale of
- 50 <u>distilled spirits or alcohol.</u>
- 51 (c) It is unlawful for the licensee to sell or dispose of any such distilled spirits or alcohol:
- 52 (1) In any municipality, county, or unincorporated area of a county in which the sale of
- 53 <u>distilled spirits or alcohol is prohibited by this chapter; or</u>
- 54 (2) To any person not holding an importer's, broker's, or wholesaler's license issued
- 55 pursuant to this chapter or by another state.
- 56 (d) A manufacturer's or distiller's license may be issued pursuant to this Code section for
- 57 the manufacture of distilled spirits from agricultural products other than perishable fruits
- in any county or municipality of this state that has approved either the package sale of
- 59 <u>distilled spirits or the sale of distilled spirits by the drink, or both, as provided in this</u>
- 60 <u>chapter.</u>

61 (e) A manufacturer or distiller issued a license pursuant to this Code section may provide

62 <u>educational and promotional tours.</u>"

63 SECTION 3.

64 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
