- 1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Scott Uhlich; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Scott Uhlich has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the
3 vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare
4 of the citizens of Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Mr. Uhlich earned a Bachelor of Science in environmental health from the
6 University of Georgia and a master's degree in city planning from Georgia Tech and is a
7 graduate of the CDC Environmental Public Health Leadership Institute; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Mr. Uhlich began his environmental health career in 1979 as a sanitarian for the
9 Gwinnett County Health Department, where he moved up the ranks to senior sanitarian and
10 registered sanitarian; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he served as the district environmental health director for the Athens Public
12 Health District and public health engineer and land use program director for the Department
13 of Public Health's environmental health and injury prevention branch and is currently director
14 of environmental health for the Department of Public Health, where he oversees all
15 environmental health program activities; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Mr. Uhlich continues to promote the importance of environmental health
17 programs in public health, and in his position he oversaw the successful implementation of
18 a new Georgia Food Code and training/standardization of all county environmental health
19 staff; and
- 20 WHEREAS, he was recognized by the Georgia Public Health Association as the
21 Environmentalist of the Year in 1995; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Uhlich has served with honor and distinction in the field of public health
23 and his vision and unyielding commitment have set the standard for public service; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
25 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
