| 10 | transportation, is amended by repealing in their entirety Code Sections 32-9-13 and 32-9-14, |
| 11 | relating to the suspension of restrictions on the use of annual proceeds from sales and use |
| 12 | taxes by public transit authorities and the board of directors of the Metropolitan Atlanta |
| 13 | Rapid Transit Authority, respectively. |

SECTION 2.

This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2013, only if an Act providing for the suspension of restrictions on the use of annual proceeds from sales and use taxes by the Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority and reconstituting the board of directors of the Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority is enacted at the 2012 regular session of the General Assembly. Otherwise, this Act shall not become effective and shall stand repealed on January 1, 2013.
