A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 36-82-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 elections for approval of bonded debt, so as to change certain provisions relating to
- 3 population brackets and the census; to amend Code Section 45-8-12 of the Official Code of
- 4 Georgia Annotated, relating to deposit of public funds in banks or depositories, so as to
- 5 exempt hospital authorities from certain requirements; to provide for related matters; to
- 6 provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 36-82-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elections for
- 10 approval of bonded debt, is amended by revising subsection (b.1) as follows:
- 11 "(b.1) In all counties of this state having a population of 800,000 900,000 or more
- according to the United States decennial census of 2000 <u>2010</u> or any future such census,
- 13 no county-wide bond election or school bond election in the unincorporated area of any
- such county shall be held on any date other than the date of the November general election;
- provided, however, that upon a determination by any superior court of competent
- jurisdiction that the holding of such election on the date of the November general election
- would cause irreparable harm to the electors of any such county, such election shall be held
- in the manner provided for in subsection (b) of this Code section."
- 19 SECTION 1A.
- 20 Code Section 45-8-12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to deposit of
- 21 public funds in banks or depositories, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as
- 22 follows:

- 23 "(f) This Code section shall not apply to public funds of a hospital authority created
- 24 pursuant to Article 4 of Chapter 7 of Title 31."
