A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 14 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to the Office of Student Achievement, so as to provide that a private
- 3 college that submits confidential student data and records to the Office of Student
- 4 Achievement shall not be liable for the breach of the confidentiality of such data and records
- 5 by the Office of Student Achievement; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective
- 6 date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 9 Part 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 14 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 10 relating to the Office of Student Achievement, is amended by adding a new Code section to

- 13 (a) When private colleges and universities in this state provide the Office of Student
- 14 Achievement with confidential student data or records concerning students enrolled in such
- private colleges and universities, such private colleges and universities shall not be held
- liable in any court in this state for any breach of confidentiality, disclosure, use, retention,
- or destruction of such information if such breach, disclosure, use, retention, or destruction
- resulted from actions of the Office of Student Achievement or its staff and not from the
- 19 <u>transmission of the information by the private college or university before such information</u>
- 20 <u>reached the Office of Student Achievement.</u>
- 21 (b) This Code section shall apply to any student data or records that are confidential under
- 22 any law of this state or any federal law, including, but not limited to, the federal Family
- Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 20 U.S.C. Section 1232g."
