## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To abolish the office of elected county surveyor of Henry County; to provide for the
- 2 appointment of a county surveyor; to provide for contingent effective dates; to repeal
- 3 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 (a) Pursuant to the authority of Code Section 36-7-2.1 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 7 Annotated, the office of elected county surveyor of Henry County is abolished.
- 8 (b) The Board of Commissioners of Henry County shall appoint a county surveyor. The
- 9 county surveyor shall be appointed for an indefinite term and shall serve at the pleasure of
- 10 the Board of Commissioners. A person appointed county surveyor shall possess the
- qualifications specified by paragraph (1) of subsection (b) of Code Section 36-7-2 of the
- 12 Official Code of Georgia Annotated.

13 SECTION 2.

- 14 (a) This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming
- 15 law without such approval, except as otherwise provided by subsection (b) of this section.
- 16 (b) If there is an elected surveyor of Henry County holding office on the date this Act is
- 17 approved by the Governor or becomes law without such approval, then this Act shall become
- 18 effective upon the expiration of the current term of office of the surveyor.

19 SECTION 3.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
