A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to crimes and offenses, so as to provide for the new crime of false lien statements against public officers or public employees; to provide for definitions; to provide for penalties; to provide a cross-reference; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to crimes and offenses, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows: 9 10 ″<u>16-10-20.1.</u> 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term: 12 (1) 'Public employee' means every person employed by the executive, legislative, or 13 judicial branch of state government, or any department, board, bureau, agency, 14 commission, or authority thereof, and any person employed by a county, municipality, 15 consolidated government, or local board of education. 16 (2) 'Public officer' shall have the same meaning as set forth in Code Section 21-5-3. (b) Notwithstanding Code Sections 16-10-20 and 16-10-71, it shall be unlawful for any 17 person to knowingly file a false lien or encumbrance in a public record or private record 18 19 that is generally available to the public against the real or personal property of a public 20 officer or public employee on account of the performance of such public officer or public employee's official duties, knowing or having reason to know that such lien or 21 encumbrance is false or contains a materially false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or 22 23 representation. 24 (c) Any person who violates subsection (b) of this Code section shall be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment of not less than one nor 25 more than ten years, a fine not to exceed \$10,000.00, or both." 26
