## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 9-11-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 process, so as to change provisions relating to who may serve process; to amend Code
- 3 Section 15-6-77 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees collected by
- 4 superior court clerks, so as to provide for filing fees for applications for certified process
- 5 servers; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 9-11-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to process, is
- 9 amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:
- 10 "(c) **Summons By whom served.** Process shall be served by:
- 11 (1) The sheriff of the county where the action is brought or where the defendant is found
- or by such sheriff's deputy;

- 13 (2) The marshal or sheriff of the court or by such official's deputy;
- 14 (3) Any citizen of the United States specially appointed by the court for that purpose;
- 15 (4) A person who is not a party and is, not younger than 18 years of age, and has been
- appointed by the court to serve process or as a permanent process server by the court in
- 17 which the action is brought; or
- 18 (5) A certified process server <del>under</del> as provided in Code Section 9-11-4.1<del>, provided that</del>
- 19 the sheriff of the county for which process is to be served allows such servers to serve
- 20 process in such county.
- Where the service of process is made outside of the United States, after an order of
- publication, it may be served either by any citizen of the United States or by any resident
- of the country, territory, colony, or province who is specially appointed by the court for
- 24 that purpose. When service is to be made within this state, the person making such service
- shall make the service within five days from the time of receiving the summons and

- 29 Code Section 15-6-77 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees collected
- 30 by superior court clerks, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 31 "(p) Notwithstanding any provision of this Code section to the contrary, the filing fee for
- an application to be appointed as a certified process server pursuant to paragraph (2) of
- 33 <u>subsection (h) of Code Section 9-11-4.1 shall be \$58.00."</u>

## 34 SECTION 3.

35 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
