A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To provide the director of the pretrial release program for the Southern Judicial Circuit and
- 2 such other members of the staff of such program as may be designated by the chief judge of
- 3 such judicial circuit with arrest and certain other powers; to provide for related matters; to
- 4 provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 The director of the pretrial release program for the Southern Judicial Circuit or any county
- 8 within such circuit shall have the same power to make arrests; to execute and return all
- 9 warrants, rules, orders, and processes of any kind; and to serve as a peace officer and perform
- 10 the same duties as may be performed by a sheriff. Other staff members of the pretrial release
- program the chief judge of the Southern Judicial Circuit designates by order in his or her
- discretion as he or she shall deem necessary for the proper functioning of the pretrial release
- program shall have the same power to make arrests; to execute and return all warrants, rules,
- orders, and processes of any kind; and to serve as a peace officer and perform the same duties
- as may be performed by a sheriff.

SECTION 2.

- 17 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 18 without such approval.

19 SECTION 3.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
