#### A RESOLUTION

- 4 WHEREAS, Lorene Walker was born on October 16, 1947, in Sumter County, Georgia, a

- 6 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Mrs. Tindol was an active member of

- 19 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Judge Tindol will long be remembered
