A RESOLUTION

1 Commending William L. Durban III on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, William L. Durban III earned the rank of Eagle Scout, awarded during a
3 ceremony on May 28, 2011; and

4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle has been the symbol of the highest achievement among
5 the Boy Scouts of America; and

6 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed
7 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities
8 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and

9 WHEREAS, William L. Durban III has amply demonstrated to his Scout leaders and peers
10 that he possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and

11 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are
12 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and

14 only to himself but also to his family and troop.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body

17 the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining
