A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing regret at the passing of Homer Childs; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia recently lost one of its finest and most distinguished
3 citizens with the passing of Homer Childs; and

4 WHEREAS, he diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
5 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
6 dramatically by his many years of commitment to and support of Robins Air Force Base and
7 the Museum of Aviation and his service as a member, officer, and supporter of the Carl
8 Vinson Chapter of the Air Force Association; and

9 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
10 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this
11 state, and especially Warner Robins, earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues
12 and associates; and

13 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentleman gave inspiration to many through his high ideals,
14 morals, and deep concern for his fellow citizens and he possessed the vast wisdom which
15 only comes through experience and the strength of character which is achieved through
16 overcoming the many challenges of life; and

17 WHEREAS, he served his country with honor and distinction as a United States Marine and
18 was a humble man who never sought the spotlight or credit for his many charitable deeds and
19 who was interested only in helping his community; and

20 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
21 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he
22 made this world a better place in which to live.
