## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Dr. Phillip A. Callicutt; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Dr. Phillip A. Callicutt began service with the Federal Law Enforcement  
3 Training Centers (FLETC) in May, 1976, and in June, 2011, he was named the senior policy  
4 and project analyst for the newly established Centralized Training Management Directorate;  
5 and

6 WHEREAS, during his tenure at the FLETC, Dr. Callicutt has served in various staff and  
7 supervisory positions at both the Glynco and Artesia sites, including team leader, branch  
8 chief, and assistant division chief of the Physical Techniques Division and as a member of  
9 the start-up team to establish Artesia as a FLETC training site, and Dr. Callicutt also served  
10 in a variety of supervisory roles, including chief of the Special Training Division and chief  
11 of the Artesia Training Division; and

12 WHEREAS, from 2001 to the present, Dr. Callicutt has served as the SPPA for the Office  
13 of Training, the Training Directorate, the Administration Directorate, the Field Training  
14 Directorate, and the CTMD, and in addition to his supervisory and staff positions,  
15 Dr. Callicutt has served as an instructor at the International Law Enforcement Academies in  
16 Budapest, Hungary, and San Salvador, El Salvador, and in 2003, he served as the component  
17 representative on the DHS Max HR Project; and

18 WHEREAS, prior to his service with the federal government, Dr. Callicutt served as a  
19 football trainer in the National Football League and at Florida State University, West  
20 Virginia University, and Iowa State University and as associate director of the State of North  
21 Carolina Sports Medicine Program; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Callicutt holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Physical Education for Men  
23 from Iowa State University and a Master of Science degree in Secondary Education from  
24 West Virginia University, where he also spent two years as a doctoral candidate, and he

25 completed his Doctorate in Education at California Western University in Curriculum and  
26 Instruction, and in addition, Dr. Callicutt is a graduate of the Federal Executive Institute,  
27 where he was selected by his classmates to give the graduation speech, and in April, 2011,  
28 Dr. Callicutt was awarded a Certificate in Change Leadership from Cornell University; and

29 WHEREAS, Dr. Callicutt is married to the former Dianne Hulin from High Point, North  
30 Carolina, and the couple have two daughters, Heather Callicutt and Dr. Ashley Callicutt, who  
31 is currently a Critical Incident Stress Management Counselor at the FLETC; and

32 WHEREAS, it is only right and proper that this outstanding citizen be recognized and  
33 honored for his many impressive accomplishments and his service to his country.

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
35 the members of this body recognize and honor Dr. Phillip A. Callicutt as an outstanding  
36 citizen of this state.
