A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- To amend Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 1
- 2 relating to general provisions relative to water resources, so as to reestablish the Georgia
- 3 Geospatial Advisory Council and provide for its membership; to provide for definitions;
- 4 to provide legislative intent; to provide for duties; to provide for rules and regulations; to
- 5 provide for automatic repeal; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 6 for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

- 9 Article 1 of Chapter 5 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 general provisions relative to water resources, is amended by adding a new Code section to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 "<u>12-5-9.</u>

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- 13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 14 (1) 'Director' means the director of the division.
- 15 (2) 'Division' means the Environmental Protection Division of the department.
- (b) It is the intent of the General Assembly to provide the general public with access to 16
- 17 reliable geospatial data, including but not limited to flood map modernization. Currently,
- 18 Georgia lacks many of the components which would provide for reliable data such as
- 19 geospatial coordination and collaboration, policies, standards, state-wide geospatial
- datasets, current inventory, state-wide license agreements, business and strategic plans, 20
- 21 trained work force, data life cycle support, and contract and program management support.
- 22 (c)(1) In order to provide reliable geospatial data to the public, there shall be created the
- Georgia Geospatial Advisory Council. The division shall coordinate the creation of such 23
- council. The division shall coordinate with state executive branch departments and
- 25 agencies to appoint members of the council, which may consist of representatives from
- 26 state departments and agencies, local governments, universities, regional commissions,

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27 or any other entity the division determines to be a stakeholder active in the development or consumption of reliable geospatial resources. 28 29 (2) The council shall meet initially upon the call of the director and shall elect a 30 chairperson at the initial meeting. Subsequent meetings shall be called by the chairperson. The members of the council shall serve at the pleasure of the director. 31 32 Councilmembers shall receive no compensation for their services as members of the 33 council, but their travel expenses, if any, related to the performance of their official duties may be covered by the departments, agencies, or organizations they represent. 34 (3) The council shall audit Georgia's geospatial capabilities at county, regional, and state 35 36 levels. The audit shall contain a complete status update and recommendations for utilizing the geospatial capabilities in Georgia to meet Federal Emergency Management 37 38 Agency notification requirements, recommendations for moving forward to achieve 39 governmental data interoperability and enhanced delivery of services to Georgia citizens through the geospatial approach, and any other information determined by the council to 40 41 be necessary for the advancement of geospatial technology. 42 (4) The council shall closely coordinate its efforts with the Georgia Technology 43 Authority to ensure compliance with all state and federal standards, contracts, and 44 procedures. 45 (5) The reports generated by the council shall be made available on an annual basis by

- the department to the members of the General Assembly, all departments and agencies 46
- 47 of state government, and all county and municipal governments and shall be posted on
- 48 the Internet website of the department.
- 49 (d) The Board of Natural Resources shall promulgate such rules and regulations as may
- 50 be reasonable and necessary for the administration of this Code section.
- 51 (e) This Code section shall stand repealed on June 30, 2016."

53 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
