- 13 WHEREAS, for his Eagle project, Zac remodeled the picnic area at Kings Academy High
14 School by cleaning and painting a wall, adding tables, and then pruning all of the shrubbery
15 and adding mulch along the main entrance of the school building so students and faculty
16 could enjoy a tidy eating area; and
- 17 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Zac has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
18 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
19 becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
21 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
23 commend Zachariah A. Conley for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor
24 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him for attaining the prestigious
