## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Ms. Latashia Diane Head; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Ms. Latashia Diane Head; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Ms. Head, a member of the Quitman 10 in Brooks County, Georgia, was a  
5 beloved daughter of Leroy Head, Sr., and the late Bettye Davis Head; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Ms. Head was an active member and served  
7 as secretary at Liberty Baptist Church; and
- 8 WHEREAS, she was dedicated to the cause of equal voting rights and helped older and  
9 infirm African Americans exercise their right to vote through absentee ballot; and
- 10 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
11 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to  
12 her family and friends were admired by others; and
- 13 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Ms. Head will long be remembered for  
14 her love of family and friendship, and this loyal daughter and friend will be missed by all  
15 who had the great fortune of knowing her.
