A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions regarding military, emergency management, and veterans affairs, so as
- 3 to prohibit the state, any political subdivision of the state, any employee of the state or of a
- 4 political subdivision of the state, and any member of the Georgia National Guard or State
- 5 Defense Force while on official state duty to assist any agency of or the armed forces of the
- 6 United States in the execution of 50 U.S.C. Section 1541; to provide for related matters; to
- 7 provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Chapter 1 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- provisions regarding military, emergency management, and veterans affairs, is amended by
- 12 adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 13 "38-1-3.
- Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no agency of this state, no political
- 15 <u>subdivision of this state, no employee of an agency of this state or of a political subdivision</u>
- of this state acting in his or her official capacity, and no member of the Georgia National
- 17 Guard or State Defense Force on official state duty shall engage in any activity that aids
- an agency of or the armed forces of the United States in the execution of 50 U.S.C. Section
- 19 <u>1541 as provided by the federal National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012</u>
- 20 (P. L. 112-81, Section 1021) in the investigation, prosecution, or detainment of any citizen
- of the United States in violation of the Georgia Constitution."
- SECTION 2.
- 23 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 24 without such approval.
