- 15 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Kyle Olbert Loughman has truly exhibited a
16 commitment to the scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently
17 conducted himself in a manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
19 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

21 commend Kyle Olbert Loughman for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest
