A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Alec Trent Harp; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Alec Trent Harp has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished
3 rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and Alec
8 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught
9 through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 580 in Lilburn, Georgia;

- 12 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout project, Alec led a group of Scouts and other volunteers in
13 installing 24 landscape lights along the sidewalk in the backyard of the Family for Keeps
14 Transition Care Home in Lilburn, Georgia, and landscaping the backyard to accentuate the
15 lights and natural elements of the yard; volunteers spent a total of 148.5 hours over two days
16 improving the safety and aesthetics of the yard; and
- 17 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man has demonstrated great leadership skills and
18 initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America program; and
- 19 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Alec has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
20 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
21 becoming an Eagle Scout; and

22 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
23 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 commend Alec Trent Harp for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor
26 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious
27 rank of Eagle Scout.
