

House Bill 108

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

To amend an Act providing appropriations for the State Fiscal Year 2012-2013 known as the "General Appropriations Act," Act No. 775, approved May 7, 2012 (Ga. L. 2012, Volume One, Appendix, commencing at page 1 of 175), so as to change certain appropriations for the State Fiscal Year 2012-2013; to make language and other changes; to reallocate certain funds; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

PART I

An Act providing appropriations for the State Fiscal Year 2012-2013 known as the "General Appropriations Act," Act No. 775, approved May 7, 2012 (Ga. L. 2012, Volume One, Appendix, commencing at page 1 of 175), is amended by striking everything following the Part I designation through Section 56, and by substituting in lieu thereof the following:

"That the sums of money hereinafter provided are appropriated for the State Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2012, and ending June 30, 2013, as prescribed hereinafter for such fiscal year."

PART II

This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

PART III

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
