- 2 WHEREAS, Joe Cullen has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank
3 conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and Joe
8 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught
9 through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man has demonstrated great leadership skills and
11 initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America program; and
- 12 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout project, Joe implemented a compass course on the grounds
13 of the summer camp at Westminster Schools complete with plaques mounted on trees that
14 identify landmarks, explain compass bearings, and provide environmental information about
15 the area surrounding the landmarks so that students following the course may learn the
16 essential skill of using a compass for navigation and have a better understanding of their
17 natural surroundings; and
- 18 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Joe has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
19 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
20 becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
22 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body commend Joe Cullen for his diligence and dedication in pursuing
25 the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him for attaining
26 the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
