#### A RESOLUTION

15 workers while at Certainteed and helped negotiate the first union with the company; and

16 WHEREAS, he diligently and conscientiously devoted his time, talents, and energy to  
17 Certainteed for 45 years, all while running a thriving car business with the help of his cousin;

19 WHEREAS, today, Mr. Addison owns and operates two car dealerships and serves as an  
20 inspiration to others of what can be achieved with hard work, determination, and a dream;

23 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
