## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February 5, 2013, as Columbus Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Columbus region of Georgia is known for its fantastic visitor attractions,  
3 expansive economic growth and development, and beautiful natural landscapes; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the region is known for its public and private partnerships that have generated  
5 success for the area with projects such as the RiverCenter for the Performing Arts and the  
6 Valley Partnership Joint Development Authority; and
- 7 WHEREAS, for nearly 15 years, the Greater Columbus Chamber of Commerce has  
8 journeyed to larger cities around the country to learn how to improve the Columbus area and  
9 identify what steps can be taken to foster growth and development; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Columbus is home to numerous national and international institutions, including  
11 Aflac, Carmike Cinemas, NCR, Fort Benning, Synovus, TSYS, and the W.C. Bradley  
12 Company; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Columbus features exciting attractions such as the 15 mile Riverwalk, the  
14 RiverCenter for the Performing Arts, the Columbus Convention and Trade Center, the  
15 Columbus Civic Center and Skating Rink, the South Commons softball complex, historic  
16 Golden Park, a skateboard park, the Columbus Museum, the Springer Opera House, and the  
17 Liberty Theater; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the citizens of the Greater Columbus region are justly proud of their  
19 community, its past, and its many contributions to this state, and it is only proper to  
20 recognize February 5, 2013, as Columbus Day at the state capitol.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
22 recognize February 5, 2013, as Columbus Day at the state capitol and congratulate the  
23 Greater Columbus region on its many outstanding accomplishments.
