#### A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Habersham County and recognizing February 20, 2013, as Habersham County  
2 day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, established in 1818, Habersham County was named for Colonel Joseph  
4 Habersham and was originally an area of 713 square miles; and

5 WHEREAS, with a present size at 279 square miles and a population approaching 45,000,  
6 Habersham provides a diverse culture and is home to Tallulah Gorge, the Niagra Falls of the  
7 South; and

8 WHEREAS, Poet Sidney Lanier waxed about the county's southwest border, the  
9 Chattahooche River, in *The Song of the Chattahoochee*, "out of the hills of Habersham, down  
10 the valleys of Hall;" and

11 WHEREAS, holding the distinction of starting and ending in Habersham County, the Soque  
12 Rivers offers the best fly fishing east of the Mississippi, and other outdoor attractions in  
13 Habersham include Lake Russell, Panther Creek Falls, and many beautiful waterfalls, hiking  
14 trails, and rafting opportunities; and

15 WHEREAS, Habersham County's Clarkesville was voted by a *Randy McNally* poll as the  
16 number two Best Small Town for Retirement in the United States, with state-of-the-art  
17 medical facilities and a nationally recognized hospital; and

18 WHEREAS, Habersham is home to five historical museums and two historic colleges,  
19 Piedmont College, with doctorate degree programs, and North Georgia Technical College,  
20 the first technical college in the state; and

21 WHEREAS, with farming as the number one industry in Habersham and tourism as number  
22 two, Habersham offers attractions from outdoor recreation to cultural activities, including art  
23 galleries and active community theater; and

24 WHEREAS, Habersham provides a supportive environment for business and industry, with  
25 existing industries ranging from international companies to small businesses; and

26 WHEREAS, Habersham County continues to look with optimism toward the future while  
27 keeping the proud memory of its beginning close to its heart to share with succeeding  
28 generation.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
30 commend Habersham County on its distinguished history and recognize February 20, 2013,  
31 as Habersham County Day at the state capitol.
