## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending David Masiarczyk; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, David Masiarczyk, has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished  
3 rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and

4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a  
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques  
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and

7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and David  
8 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught  
9 through the Boy Scout program; and

10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 1101, Dragon Patrol, and  
11 has demonstrated great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scout  
12 program; and

13 WHEREAS, this is only the third time in the history of Troop 1101 that 100 percent of all  
14 the boys in the patrol have received their Eagle rank together; and

15 WHEREAS, as his Eagle Scout project, David constructed a woodshed behind the HOPE  
16 house at Mt. Bethel United Methodist Church; the woodshed, which is on top of a concrete  
17 slab and consists of a wooden frame covered by a roof, will store and keep dry firewood that  
18 will be used by the HOPE House, Mt. Bethel Church and Academy, and the Boy Scouts; and

19 WHEREAS, this outstanding young man has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting  
20 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner  
21 becoming an Eagle Scout; and

22 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader  
23 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
25 commend David Masiarczyk for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor  
26 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious  
27 rank of Eagle Scout.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
29 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to David Masiarczyk.
