A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending John Parks Chandler, Jr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, John Parks Chandler, Jr., has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most
3 distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and John
8 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught
9 through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 1101, Dragon Patrol, and
11 has demonstrated great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scout
12 program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, this is only the third time in the history of Troop 1101 that 100 percent of all
14 the boys in the patrol have received their Eagle rank together; and
- 15 WHEREAS, as his Eagle Scout project, John remodeled the outdoor classroom at Brumby
16 Elementary on Powers Ferry Road, removing old worn benches and replacing them with new
17 benches that were stained and placed in an amphitheater style setting, replacing the
18 whiteboard and roof covering, covering the ground with mulch, and performing other minor
19 landscaping; and
- 20 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, John has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
21 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
22 becoming an Eagle Scout; and

23 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
24 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
26 commend John Parks Chandler, Jr., for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest
27 honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
28 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
