A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Valdosta-Lowndes County Chamber of Commerce on its
2 100 years of continuous service to its members and to its community; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Valdosta-Lowndes County Chamber of Commerce was established in 1912
4 to represent the businesses in its community; and

5 WHEREAS, the mission of the chamber is to serve as the unifying force and focal point for
6 enhancing the economic, social, and cultural well-being of the regional community it serves;

8 WHEREAS, the Valdosta-Lowndes Chamber is one of the largest chambers in Georgia with
9 nearly 1,500 members; and

10 WHEREAS, the Valdosta-Lowndes Chamber is one of only 77 chambers of commerce
11 nationwide to be accredited by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce as a 5-star Chamber; and

13 developing their community and providing significant contributions to the State of Georgia;

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments and the
16 100th anniversary of the Valdosta-Lowndes County Chamber of Commerce be appropriately
17 recognized.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 commend the Valdosta-Lowndes County Chamber of Commerce for its contributions to the
20 citizens of Lowndes County, congratulate the Chamber of Commerce on its 100th
