- 14 beneath deep waters, fulfilling her mission of protecting peace and fighting for freedom; and
- WHEREAS, all Georgians will anxiously await the safe return of the USS *Georgia* and thosewho travel with her.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
  the members of this body commend the USS *Georgia* and recognize January 30, 2013, as
  USS *Georgia* Day.
