- 4 WHEREAS, the American Heart Association's Go Red For Women movement has been
- 5 impacting the health of women for ten years, and more than 627,000 women's lives have
- 6 been saved and 330 fewer women are dying every day; and
- 7 WHEREAS, heart disease is the number one killer of women, yet only one in five American
- 8 women believe that heart disease is her greatest health threat; and
- 9 WHEREAS, cardiovascular diseases cause one in three women's deaths each year, killing
- 10 approximately one woman every minute; and
- 11 WHEREAS, an estimated 43 million women in the U.S. are affected by cardiovascular
- 12 diseases; and
- 13 WHEREAS, 90 percent of women have one or more risk factors for developing heart
- 14 disease; and
- 15 WHEREAS, women comprise only 24 percent of participants in all heart related studies; and
- 16 WHEREAS, since 1984, more women than men have died each year from heart disease and
- 17 the gap between men's and women's survival continues to widen; and
- 18 WHEREAS, women are less likely to call 911 for themselves when experiencing symptoms
- 19 of a heart attack than they are if someone else were having a heart attack; and
