5 WHEREAS, Bishop Harris was born in 1943 in Albany, Georgia, where he received his 6 education; and

7 WHEREAS, a veteran of the United States Army, Bishop Harris devoted innumerable hours 8 of his time to facilitating liberty and equality within his country as he was also a freedom 9 singer for justice and a field worker for the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee and 10 the Southern Christian Leadership Conference; and

11 WHEREAS, Bishop Harris worked with Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and many other 12 pioneers of the Civil Rights Movement to put an end to African American oppression; and

13 WHEREAS, he co-founded the Veterans Civil Rights Movement Organization SCLC

14 affiliated chapter, and in 1998, he was honored for his contributions to ending suffering for

15 African Americans in the New Albany Civil Rights Museum in Albany, Georgia; and

16 WHEREAS, in the late 1960s and early 1970s, Bishop Harris was a recording artist with Emory and The Dynamics under Peachtree Record label, and during his career, he performed 17 18 with artists such as Jerry Butler, Jackie Wilson, Curtis Mayfield and the Impressions, David 19 Ruffin, and Mitty Collier; and

20 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Bishop Harris was called into the ministry by the Lord in 1977 and served as Dean of Ministers of the Northern Diocese for nine years 21 22 before he was appointed State Evangelist for the Northern Diocese Churches of Our Lord
