A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 3 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to parks, historic areas, memorials, and recreation generally, so as to require the
- 3 Department of Natural Resources to notify local governing authorities before making certain
- 4 significant changes in services at state parks, historic sites, or recreational areas located
- 5 within the area of the local governing authority; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 1 of Chapter 3 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 parks, historic areas, memorials, and recreation generally, is amended by adding a new Code
- 11 section to read as follows:
- 12 "<u>12-3-12.</u>
- 13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'change in services' means the:
- (1) Permanent change of a primary existing operational function;
- 15 (2) Reduction by 50 percent or more of the hours of operation or services; or
- 16 <u>(3) Closure</u>
- of any state park, historic site, or recreational area operated by or pursuant to the authority
- of the department.
- 19 (b) Prior to making a change in services, the department shall provide 90 days' notice to
- 20 the governing authority of each municipality and county in which any part of the state park,
- 21 <u>historic site, or recreational area is located regarding the specific proposed change in</u>
- 22 <u>services</u>. The notice required by this Code section shall be made in writing and sent to the
- 23 applicable chairperson of the county commissioners and the mayor of the municipality."

SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
