9 process as a lobbyist working to help people and the environment; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Rachel Fowler was blessed with two remarkable daughters, Sherree Hill and
11 Susan Sawyer, and two wonderful grandsons as well as one cherished great-grandson; and
- 12 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern
13 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to
14 her family and friends were admired by others; and
- 15 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
16 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,
17 she made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 18 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Rachel Fowler will long be remembered
19 for the love of her family, the appreciation of the Georgia state government, and the affection
20 of the Garden Club of Georgia; and this loyal public servant and friend will be missed by all
21 who had the great fortune of knowing her.

23 join in honoring the life and memory of Rachel Fowler and express their deepest and most
24 sincere regret at her passing.
