AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To repeal an Act creating a new charter for Payne City, approved May 16, 2007 (Ga. L.
- 2 2007, p. 3555), so as to abolish Payne City; to provide for the disposition of the assets,
- 3 property, and legal rights and obligations of the city and the winding up of city affairs; to
- 4 provide for submission under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 An Act creating a new charter for Payne City, approved May 16, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007,
- 9 p. 3555), is repealed, and Payne City is abolished. The assets, property, and legal rights and
- 10 obligations of the city shall devolve upon the governing authority of Macon-Bibb County,
- and the affairs of the city shall be wound up, all the same as provided for a terminated
- municipality under subsection (g) of Code Section 36-30-7.1 of the O.C.G.A.

13 SECTION 2.

- 14 The governing authority of Macon-Bibb County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act
- 15 to be submitted for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended;
- and such submission shall be made to the United States Department of Justice or filed with
- 17 the appropriate court no later than 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the
- 18 Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.

19 SECTION 3.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
