A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 11 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to miscellaneous provisions of uniform rules of the road, so as to increase the penalties for failure to properly secure a load on a motor vehicle; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** Article 11 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 8 9 miscellaneous provisions of uniform rules of the road, is amended by revising Code Section 10 40-6-254, relating to operating a vehicle without adequately securing a load, as follows: 11 "40-6-254. 12 No person shall operate any motor vehicle with a load on or in such vehicle unless the load 13 on or in such vehicle is adequately secured to prevent the dropping or shifting of such load 14 onto the roadway in such a manner as to create a safety hazard. Any person who operates 15 a vehicle in violation of this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00." 16

This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2013, and shall apply to offenses committed onor after such date.
