5 protection of its natural resources; and

10 the Georgia Environmental Finance Authority (GEFA); and

17 protection of Georgia's energy, land, and water resources, his keen sense of vision, and his
18 awareness of the needs of the citizens of this state have earned him the respect and
19 admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

20 WHEREAS, he is a man with an unimpeachable reputation for integrity, intelligence,
21 fairness, and kindness; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Mason was united in love and marriage to his wife, Jackie, on May 27,
23 1989, and the couple has been blessed with two children, David and Moriah; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
25 distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
27 commend Mr. Greg Mason for three decades of efficient, effective, and dedicated public
28 service to the State of Georgia, congratulate him upon the grand occasion of his retirement,
