A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 2 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
Department of Transportation, so as to provide for requirements for performing value
engineering studies; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.** 7 Chapter 2 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Department 8 of Transportation, is amended by revising subsection (d) of Code Section 32-2-41.2, relating 9 to the development of benchmarks, reports, and value engineering studies by the Department 10 of Transportation, to read as follows: 11 "(d) Value engineering studies shall be performed on all projects whose costs exceed $\frac{10}{10}$ 12 \$50 million, except for any project procured in accordance with Code Section 32-2-81, and the director shall submit an annual report to the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the 13 14 Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the chairpersons of the House and Senate 15 Transportation Committees detailing the amount saved due to the value engineering studies. This report shall also be published on the website of the department." 16
