## AS PASSED SENATE

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to courts, so as to
- 2 increase penalties that can be imposed for contempt of superior and state courts; to provide
- 3 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 5 SECTION 1.
- 6 Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to courts, is amended by revising
- 7 paragraph (5) of Code Section 15-6-8, relating to jurisdiction and powers of the superior
- 8 courts, as follows:
- 9 "(5) To punish contempt by fines not exceeding  $\$500.00 \ \$1,000.00$  and by imprisonment
- not exceeding 20 days; and"
- 11 SECTION 2.
- 12 Said title is further amended by revising paragraph (5) of subsection (a) of Code Section
- 13 15-7-4, relating to jurisdiction for state courts, as follows:
- 14 "(5) The punishment of contempts contempt by fine fines not exceeding \$500.00 or
- \$1,000.00 and by imprisonment not exceeding 20 days, or both; and"
- SECTION 3.
- 17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
