A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Emory McClinton; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Emory McClinton has spent 20 years of his life dedicated to serving the
3 citizens of Georgia through the State Transportation Board, during which time he has served
4 as Board Chairman and Board Vice Chairman; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Mr. McClinton attended Tuskegee University, where he studied electrical
6 engineering, and graduated from Morehouse College with a degree in mathematics and
7 physics in 1962; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he is united in love and marriage to Mrs. JoAnn McClinton, and the two have
9 been blessed with two remarkable children and two cherished grandchildren; and
- 10 WHEREAS, an intelligent and enterprising man, Mr. McClinton has spent innumerable hours
11 of his time trying to improve this state on behalf of its citizens by serving as a State
12 Representative from the 68th District, a member of the American Association of State
13 Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO), chairman of the AASHTO Committee
14 of Board Members and Commissioners, a member of Southern Association of State Highway
15 and Transportation Officials, chairman of Boards and Commissioners, and a member of the
16 Atlanta chapter of the Conference of Minority Transportation Officials; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Mr. McClinton is currently retired from the United States Department of
18 Transportation Regional Federal Highway Administration where he served as a Senior
19 Management Official for 22 years; he also served as a Contract Administrator and Special
20 Assistant to the Regional Director of the Defense Contract Administration, a Contracting and
21 Procurement Officer with the Regional Office of the General Services Administration, and
22 an electronics engineer with the United States Postal Service Office of Research and
23 Engineering; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. McClinton continues to work diligently for the betterment of his
25 community by working with the East Lake Neighbors Association, the GDOT Board, which
26 he represents on the Atlanta Regional Commission, and the dual degree engineering program,
27 which he co-founded, between Morehouse College and Georgia Tech; and

28 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the time spent by this driven individual
29 be recognized as an invaluable service to the State of Georgia and its citizens.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
