## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 13, 2013, as University of Georgia School of Law Day at the state  
2 capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the University of Georgia School of Law was founded in 1859 as the Lumpkin  
4 School of Law by distinguished Georgia jurists Joseph Henry Lumpkin and Thomas Reade  
5 Rootes Cobb; and

6 WHEREAS, since its foundation, the University of Georgia School of Law has excelled in  
7 educating and preparing its students for successful careers at the bar; and

8 WHEREAS, the University of Georgia School of Law has served as a training ground for this  
9 state's most distinguished and honorable public servants, leaders, and statesmen; and

10 WHEREAS, the Georgia Association of Law and Politics, continuing in that tradition, opens  
11 bipartisan forums and invites discussion between students and state leaders for the purpose  
12 of advancing public policy; and

13 WHEREAS, the students of the University of Georgia School of Law are welcomed to the  
14 Gold Dome on the Second Annual University of Georgia School of Law Legislative Day at  
15 the state capitol.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
17 commend the University of Georgia School of Law as this state's preeminent provider of  
18 legal education and recognize February 1, 2013, as the University of Georgia School of Law  
19 Day at the state capitol.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed

22 Politics at the University of Georgia School of Law.
