A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Cooperative Developmental Energy Program (CDEP) at

2 Fort Valley State University; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Developmental Energy Program (CDEP) at Fort Valley State
University has been designated a national model program by the U.S. Department of Energy
and, this year, is celebrating 30 years of success in recruiting academically talented
minorities and women for disciplines in mathematics, engineering, geoscience, chemistry,
biology, and health physics; and

8 WHEREAS, CDEP is an innovative cooperative program between Fort Valley State 9 University (FVSU), the University of Nevada-Las Vegas (UNLV), the Georgia Institute of 10 Technology (GT), the University of Texas-Austin (UTEXAS), the University of Texas-Pan 11 American (UTPA), Pennsylvania State University (PSU), the University of Arkansas 12 (UARK) and the private and governmental sectors of the nation's energy industry that 13 focuses on placing minorities and females into professional level careers in the energy 14 industry; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Isaac J. Crumbly, Director of CDEP, founded the program in 1983 with start-up funds from the U.S. Department of Energy, and since that time, the program has increased its list of sponsorships to include many utility, oil, and gas companies, and governmental agencies; and

WHEREAS, CDEP operates the largest specifically focused energy internship program
among the 117 historically black colleges and universities and has placed students in more
than 900 internship assignments, resulting in combined earnings totaling more than \$5
million; and

WHEREAS, the CDEP program has received numerous awards for its accomplishments,including recognition from the nation's capitol; Dr. Crumbly was honored last year by
