A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Senate Expungement Reform Study Committee; to provide for duties and
- 2 responsibilities of the committee; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, to be wrongly accused or convicted of a crime is a life-changing event in many
- 4 circumstances; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a conviction on any person's record can cause difficulties in many areas of life,
- 6 including finances, career opportunities, and domestic relations; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the process for clearing an individual's record when he or she has been
- 8 wrongfully accused or convicted of a crime is very tedious and expensive; and
- 9 WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to undertake a study of the process for getting an
- 10 individual's record expunged to determine if it would be appropriate for Georgia to revise and
- 11 update these provisions of law.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that there is created the Senate
- 13 Expungement Reform Study Committee to be composed of the chairperson of the Senate
- 14 Judiciary Committee and four members of the Senate to be appointed by the President of the
- 15 Senate. The chairperson of the Senate Judiciary Committee shall serve as chairperson of the
- 16 committee. The committee shall meet at the call of the chairperson.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall undertake a study of the conditions,
- 18 needs, issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action
- 19 or legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate. The committee may
- 20 conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as the chairperson may deem
- 21 necessary or convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its
- 22 duties, and accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution. The members of the
- 23 committee shall receive the allowances authorized for legislative members of interim

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legislative committees from the funds appropriated to the Senate but shall receive the same for not more than five days unless additional days are authorized. All other funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds appropriated to the Senate. In the event the committee makes a report of its findings and recommendations, with suggestions for proposed legislation, if any, such report shall be made on or before December 31, 2013. The committee shall stand abolished on December 31, 2013.
