## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Carol Webb for her significant achievements; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Carol Webb, Ph.D., ABPP, has served with honor, devotion, and distinction in  
4 the field of psychology in Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, Dr. Webb's significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable  
6 patience and selflessness, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the  
7 mentally ill have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

8 WHEREAS, for the past five years, Dr. Webb has been on the board of directors of the  
9 Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards (ASPPB), an organization which  
10 seeks to enhance services and support its member jurisdictions in fulfilling their goal of  
11 advancing public protection by offering exemplary examination and credentialing programs,  
12 providing state of the art programs and services to all stakeholders, serving as the source for  
13 the most current and accurate information about the regulation of psychologists, and  
14 contributing to the critical consumer protection perspective in the ongoing development of  
15 the profession; and

16 WHEREAS, Dr. Webb served on the Georgia State Board of Examiners of Psychologists  
17 from 2002 to 2012, served as President of ASPPB in 2012, and currently serves on the board  
18 as past president, and is the director of the American Psychological Association (APA)  
19 accredited predoctoral psychology internship program for Emory University School of  
20 Medicine Department of Psychiatry, behavioral sciences at Grady Health System, and Emory  
21 Health Care Division of Neuropsychology and Behavioral Health; and

22 WHEREAS, for over 30 years, Dr. Webb has worked tirelessly at Grady to provide  
23 psychological services to the seriously mentally ill and high quality training to over 100  
24 psychology interns and postdoctoral fellows; and

25 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the dedication and vision of this  
26 remarkable and magnanimous Georgian be appropriately recognized.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
28 the members of this body commend Dr. Carol Webb for her deep personal commitment to  
29 the welfare of the citizens of Georgia.
